THE OFFERING

Barrenjoey House is a heritage listed restaurant and guest-house located in Palm Beach in Sydney, Australia.

Barrenjoey House restaurant is open for lunch and dinner, offering a relaxed yet sophisticated dining experience that Barrenjoey House is known for. The restaurant accepts reservations.

The accommodation offering includes seven guest-house style rooms located above the restaurant, each with an ensuite.

THE HISTORY OF BARRENJOEY HOUSE

Barrenjoey House is a local icon with a history spanning almost 100 years.

Barrenjoey House was originally built in 1923 by Albert Verrills, as a restaurant and guest-house for the Resch family. It was the first address in Palm Beach to install a telephone, with the number "1".

By the 1930's accommodation in Palm Beach was sought after, as the area became a popular Summer holiday spot.

The guest-house was the choice of many, including a former Prime Minister, Mr Billy Hughes, who enjoyed using the surrounding lawns to practice his golf.

During World War II Barrenjoey House became a favoured choice for service men and women to enjoy.

In the early 1980's, Barrenjoey House was purchased and restored by the previous owners Robert and Ian Gray. They retained the property until 2001, when Brendon and Jenny Barry purchased and substantially renovated the house.

Barrenjoey House was taken over by The Boathouse Group in June 2018, and after being refurbished, opened in December 2018.

The Boathouse, established in 2008 by Pip and Andrew Goldsmith, began with our Palm Beach, Sydney café.

ACCOMMODATION

Seven guest-house style rooms are located above the restaurant, each with an ensuite. Guests can choose from a Pittwater view or garden view room.

On the top level is the loft which is a larger room with a lounge room and dining table.

The restaurant is designed to be a relaxed and welcoming dining experience.

The menus have been created to offer clean and sophisticated dishes with a focus on fresh, local produce.

The restaurant is open Monday - Sunday, 11.30am - 3pm for lunch and 5pm - 9pm for dinner, reservations can be made online.

BAR

The bar menu offers drinks and light meals, and is open Monday - Sunday 11.30am - 10pm.

Reservations are not required.
